All participants in Scholarship Auditions will audition in any or all of the following; **Ballet, Jazz, Hip Hop, Tap**. Entrants will audition in their chosen subjects and perform it for the judges via Zoom. Entrants may also be asked to do a progression or center skill individually. *Due to floor/sound limitations dancers may have at home, tap is not a required subject to place in the overalls this year. Only the highest 3 scores will be used to evaluate the overall scores.*

Instructions, specific times, and Zoom links will be sent out 1 week prior to the event date.

Dress in appropriate dancewear and have appropriate shoes for each subject.

- **Girls** - One-piece black leotard, no logos or embellishments/rhinestones, no undergarments showing, tan tights. *No hair accessories or jewelry.* For hip hop and tap, black pants or shorts may be worn over leotard and tights.
- **Boys** - solid black fitted shirt, no logos or embellishments/rhinestones, with black jazz pants, black tights or black shorts above knee. *No hair accessories or jewelry.*
