All participants in Scholarship Auditions will audition in any or all of the following; **Tap, Ballet, Jazz, Hip Hop and/or Acrobatics.** Entrants will learn a combination in their chosen subjects and perform it for the judges. Entrants may also be asked to do a progression, center skill, or improv individually.

For acrobatics, students will be asked to perform a pass of no more than 3 tricks demonstrating skills such as balance, flexibility, control and power. *Students must state the 3 tricks they will be executing before performing their pass.*Transitions may be used between tricks to maintain flow and dance-like quality. Tricks may include forward and backward moving skills, however, all tricks must progress the same direction along the mat. No backtracking.

Depending on the mat setup, if a student feels they need to step backward to complete a pass, there will be no penalty as their safety is a priority.

Dress in appropriate dancewear and bring appropriate shoes for each subject.

- **Girls** One-piece black leotard, no logos or embellishments, no undergarments showing, tan tights. *No hair accessories or jewelry.* Dancers may wear black shorts for Tap and Hip Hop.
- **Boys** solid black fitted shirt, no logos or embellishments, with black jazz pants, black tights or black shorts above knee. *No hair accessories or jewelry*.

In each age division, scholarship money is awarded to a 5-phase winner, 4-phase winners (1st, 2nd, 3rd), and outstanding subject awards. Workshop scholarships will be awarded to 5-phase winner and 4-phase winners (1st, 2nd, 3rd). Certificates will be presented for all awards, including 4-phase runners up.

Dancers are only eligible for one monetary award.
